Pattie Barnes (18) is one of about a dozen teenage millionaires in Britain. Pattie makes her money from her chocolate cookies. You can buy them in supermarkets in Britain.



"It all happened by accident," says Pattie. "One Sunday last year, I decided to make some chocolate cookies. I often made them and I always used my grandma's recipe. But this time, while I was making them, I made a mistake with one of the ingredients. When I realised, I wanted to start again but I didn't have enough chocolate, so I thought, 'perhaps they'll be OK,' and I put them in the oven. And, when I tasted one... it was delicious! My friends agreed and... that's how it all started. I left school and, with my parents' help, I started a business."
